The Role

We seek a teacher who is a collaborative and supportive team player; an excellent practitioner and a caring professional. We would welcome applicants who will embrace our learning culture that includes Montessori philosophy and practice within an International Baccalaureate (IB) accredited State Primary School. Montessori 6 - 12 training is necessary. Experience in the IB Primary Years Programme (PYP) is not essential as professional development and support around learning the PYP programme will be given.

Requirements

To apply for this position you must:

- have a recognised teaching qualification,
- have Montessori 6-12 training,
- be an experienced, visionary Montessori teacher,
- possess enthusiasm, passion and exceptional people skills, and work well as part of a team,
- enjoy a dynamic, challenging role where flexibility is a necessity.

Condition of employment will be that the applicant has NZ teacher registration before commencing the position and have a relevant valid work visa or NZ residency. Commencement for this position is negotiable for 2024. We also welcome expressions of interest from suitable candidates whose current commitments may not allow for an application currently, but who would like to join our community of interested parties for future opportunities.
